

The Charterhouse Chapel

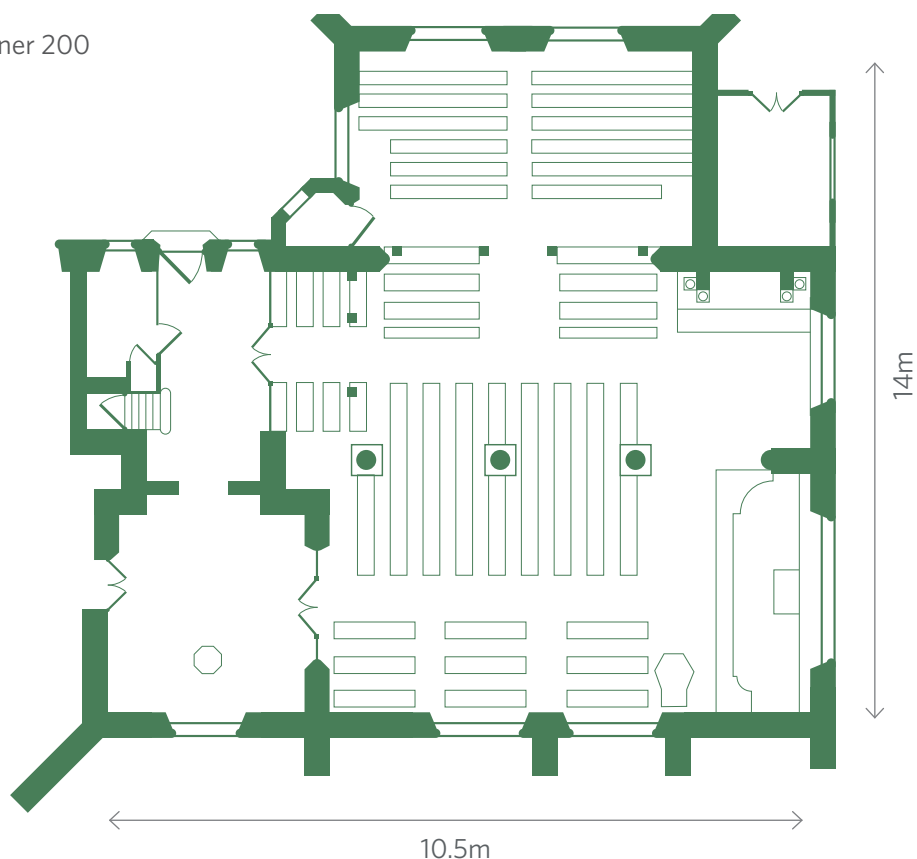


This beautiful light-filled space was originally the chapterhouse of the monastery where monks met every week to discuss matters of the day.

It then became a fine example of a Jacobean chapel later including the extraordinary memorial to the charity's founder Thomas Sutton.
