

# The Old Library



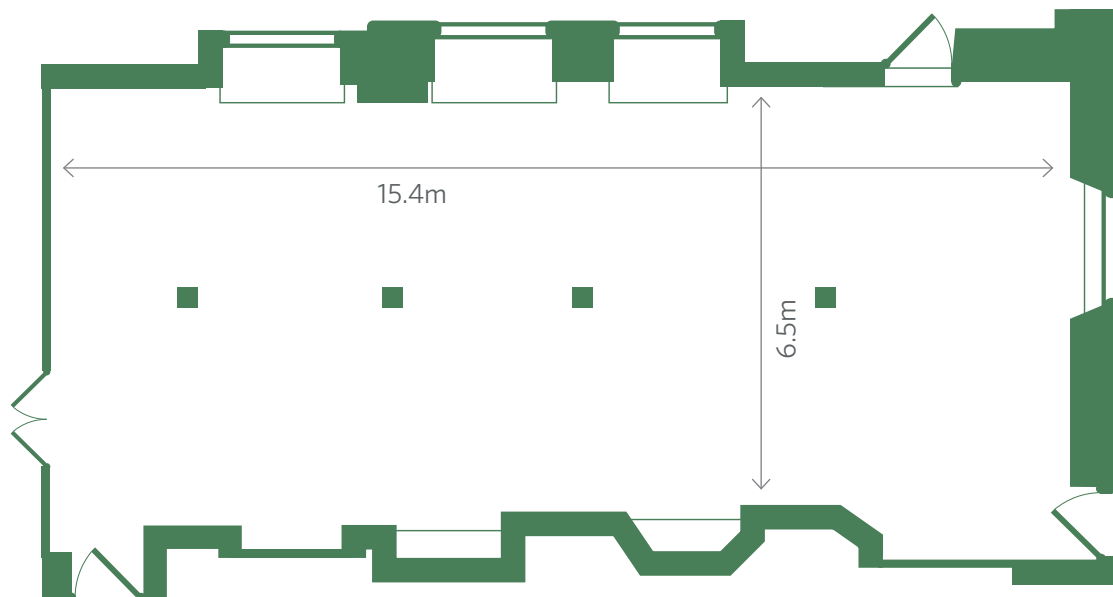
