

The Norfolk Cloister



A stunning 14th century monastery cloister which was later made into a garden gallery by the Duke of Norfolk.

A stone flag floor and original features include an original doorway leading to one of the Carthusian monk's cells. Later in the 18th century the 'offside' rule in football can claim its origins in this room, as the boys of Charterhouse School were the first to implement it in this space. With its serene atmosphere the cloister is ideal for corporate events, dinners and wine tastings.
